# cool URIs

- <http://www.w3.org/Provider/Style/URI>
- URI = uniform resource identifier
- use to identify both content online (information resources) and real-world objects and concepts of interest no online (so-called non-information resources)

# cool URIs

- mask mechanisms: /cgi-bin/foo.asp?id=x
- don't pass attributes: /~harriet/latest/
- avoid signaling file types: foo.rdf
- short, sensible, not repetitive
- cool URIs don't change
- how: apache rewrite rules and content negotiation

- Multiple formats for user/interop needs
  - example: pleiades
- Well-known formats as summaries/indexes for “full” data
- Atom as uniform finding aid
- RDF for the semantic web
- RESTful interfaces, no custom protocols
